



# Shopping and Sightseeing

Shopaholics will love Hampshire's retail offerings, which include well known high street brands, designer boutiques and independent outlets.

The historic naval city of Portsmouth is home to one of the south coast's most popular outlet shopping centres, **Gunwharf Quays**. With top quality brands such as Next, Ralph Lauren and Gap, spend a morning browsing the shops which offer heavily discounted prices. There is plenty to do other than shopping, as Gunwharf Quays is located in Portsmouth Harbour. Next door sits the famous **Historic Dockyard**, and there are harbour tours, restaurants and cafés available along the waterfront.

End your stay in Portsmouth with a visit up the 170 metre tall **Spinnaker Tower** which sits next to Gunwharf Quays. Soak up the panoramic views of Portsmouth Harbour and beyond before enjoying a light lunch at the **Café in the Clouds**.

Spend the afternoon browsing the bustling city of Winchester. Famed for its links with **King Alfred the Great**, the city has a host of boutique shops, cosy cafés and fine dining restaurants. Follow its medieval cobbled streets and uncover a new surprise around every corner. As well as shopping, the city boasts a stunning **Cathedral**, fascinating **Military Museums** and it is also home to **King Arthur's Round Table at the Great Hall**.
