GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1. The title for this competition is "Science Explained: Myth-busting Creatures at Winchester Science Centre Family Ticket Competition".
- 2. The competition is open to UK residents only (excluding residents of the Channel Islands and Isle of Man). Employees of Hampshire County Council and Beaulieu as well as their immediate families are not eligible to enter the competition. Entrants must be over the age of 18 to enter.
- 3. Entrants must follow Visit Hampshire and Winchester Science Centre on Instagram, tag a friend and comment with a snake emoji on Visit Hampshire's competition post. Entrants must provide their name and email address if selected at random as the winner. They must agree to the general terms and conditions and privacy policy.
- 4. Visit Hampshire will only ever use personal details for the purposes of administering the competition. Visit Hampshire will only keep your personal details for as long as is necessary to fulfil these purposes. Visit Hampshire will not pass on your personal information to a third party without your prior permission. Visit Hampshire abide by the General Data Protection Regulation of 2018 and complies with its provisions to ensure that any data you provide is treated accordingly.
- 5. The competition closes at 23:59 on Sunday 28th June 2023. Entries received after this date will not be considered. The prize will consist of a family ticket (2 adults and up to 3 children) to be used on Thursday 1st June 2023 at an evening event starting at 6pm and ending at 8:30pm. There will be opportunities to interact with real-life creatures, live science demos, hosted talk in the Planetarium and time to explore the Centre's two floors of interactive exhibits. The prize stated cannot be deferred or transferred. There will be no cash alternatives.
- 6. Multiple entries are allowed.
- 7. The judges' decisions will be final, and no correspondence can be entered into.
- 8. Visit Hampshire reserves the right to cancel this competition or alter any of the rules at any stage, if deemed necessary in its opinion, and if circumstances arise outside of its control.

- 9. The winner will be selected at random on Monday 29th June 2023. If the winner is unable to be contacted after reasonable attempts have been made, Visit Hampshire and Winchester Science Centre reserves the right to either offer the prize to a runner-up, or to re-offer the prize in any future competition.
- 10. These rules are governed by the laws of England and Wales. This competition is administered by Visit Hampshire (Hampshire County Council).
- 11. By entering, entrants will be deemed to have agreed to be bound by these rules and Visit Hampshire reserves the right to exclude any entry from the competition at any time and in its absolute discretion if Visit Hampshire has reason to believe that an entrant has breached these rules.
- 12. The winners' details will be shared with Winchester Science Centre. By entering the competition, the participants agree that their name may be released on social media. Your email address will NOT be shared with any other party. Entry to the competition is free. An eligible entrant must be an individual and agree to abide by these terms and conditions.
