Military Heroes

Hampshire has a rich military past and the county is known as the home of the British Army. Housed in the only surviving brick-built barrack block left in the town, **Aldershot Military Museum** tells the story of both soldier and civilian since 1854. The museum's collections include a 5.5 inch Howitzer, 25 pounder field gun and Alvis Scorpion light tank.

After your visit stop in the pretty town of Stockbridge, with its meandering River Test, boutique shops and cosy cafés. Just a short drive away in the village of Longstock, the **Peat Spade Inn** offers visitors a warm welcome and an excellent choice of home made food.

After lunch, take a short drive to the **Museum of Army Flying** just outside the centre of Stockbridge. Experience over 100 years of the army in the air, the museum is located next door to the Army Air Corps' busy working airfield. Explore 35 fixed and rotary winged aircraft and a host of artefacts which provide an informative insight in to the history of this fascinating subject.
