

Unlock Summer Competition: Win a Break to Hampshire: Terms & Conditions

GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1. The title for this competition is "Unlock Summer Hampshire Break Competition (14th September 2020)".
- 2. The competition is open to UK residents only (excluding residents of the Channel Islands and Isle of Man). Employees of Hampshire County Council and participating competition prize partners as well as their immediate families are not eligible to enter the competition. Entrants must be aged 18 and older to enter the competition. A participating competition prize partner is defined as an accommodation or attraction that is included as part of the prize. The prizes are detailed below in point five.
- 3. Entrants must provide their name, email address and postcode. Along with the correct answer to the questions and agree to the general terms and conditions and privacy policy.
- 4. Visit Hampshire will only ever use personal details for the purposes of administering the competition. Visit Hampshire will only keep your personal details for as long as is necessary to fulfil these purposes. Visit Hampshire will not pass on your personal information to a third party without your prior permission. Visit Hampshire / Hampshire County Council abide by the General Data Protection Regulation of 2018 and complies with its provisions to ensure that any data you provide is treated accordingly.
- 5. The competition closes at 23:59 on Sunday 20th September 2020. Entries received after this date will not be considered. There will be two prizes winners. All prizes are subject to availability. The prizes include:

Prize 1

A one-night midweek stay for two at The Pig in the Wall hotel (Southampton), included in the stay is dinner from the deli-bar, a glass of English fizz, breakfast and tickets to Beaulieu, Home of the National Motor Museum.
