




# Discover

## Hampshire's Countryside by Bike



- Distance:** 14 miles. Short cut trail 1: 12 miles, Short cut trail 2: 13 miles
- Start:** Start at Farley Mount Country Park, Crab Wood car park, off Chilbolton Avenue. (Grid ref. 433 293)
- Grade:** Strenuous
- Description:** A challenging route, the trail travels through the small hamlet of Farley, Ashley and the Sombornes, returning via Sparsholt and Dean.
- Links with:** Sparsholt trail, West Wood trail





# Farley Mount

## Off Road Cycle Trails



- 1** Start at Crab Wood car park (Grid ref. 433 293)
- 3** Continue Straight Across to grass track through gate. Track narrows through trees and descends steeply. (Beware of other users).
- 4** Bear Right at Heath Close Corner. Before climbing, Turn Left along track to Farm.

- 10** After gate Turn Left and continue along Clarendon Way with steep descent, track narrows to Sarum Road.

- 14** Turn Right at T-junction.

- 15** Turn Right onto track and continue south to T-junction

- 18** Turn Right at junction.

- 19** At triangle of grass Turn Left onto Home Lane to Crossroads.

- 22** As road bends sharp left, continue Straight on to track passing cottage and post box.

- 23** At staggered bridlway junction, go Straight on crossing field to road.
